- Reduced electric usage by 1,425,000 kWh annually

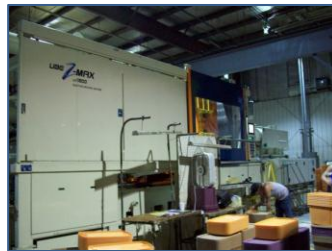
Economic Impacts:

Edge Plastics



Background:

Edge Plastics is a 30-year old family owned and operated company in Richland County, which produces plastic houseware and industrial storage containers. The company operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Challenge:

Edge Plastics is located in Mansfield, Ohio, which lies within a Priority Investment Area and is an Identified Distressed City in Regional HUB 6. Employment in this region is low and few job opportunities exist for residents. Some of the equipment used by Edge Plastics was outdated and the facility was in need of updating.

Solution:

The incentive from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act has resulted in Edge Plastic's growth and regional renewal. Two injection molding machines were installed, allowing for increased production, which in turn has allowed Edge Plastics to increase their customer base and dramatically increase sales. The new equipment has also influenced Edge Plastics suppliers to hire more employees to meet the increased demand.
