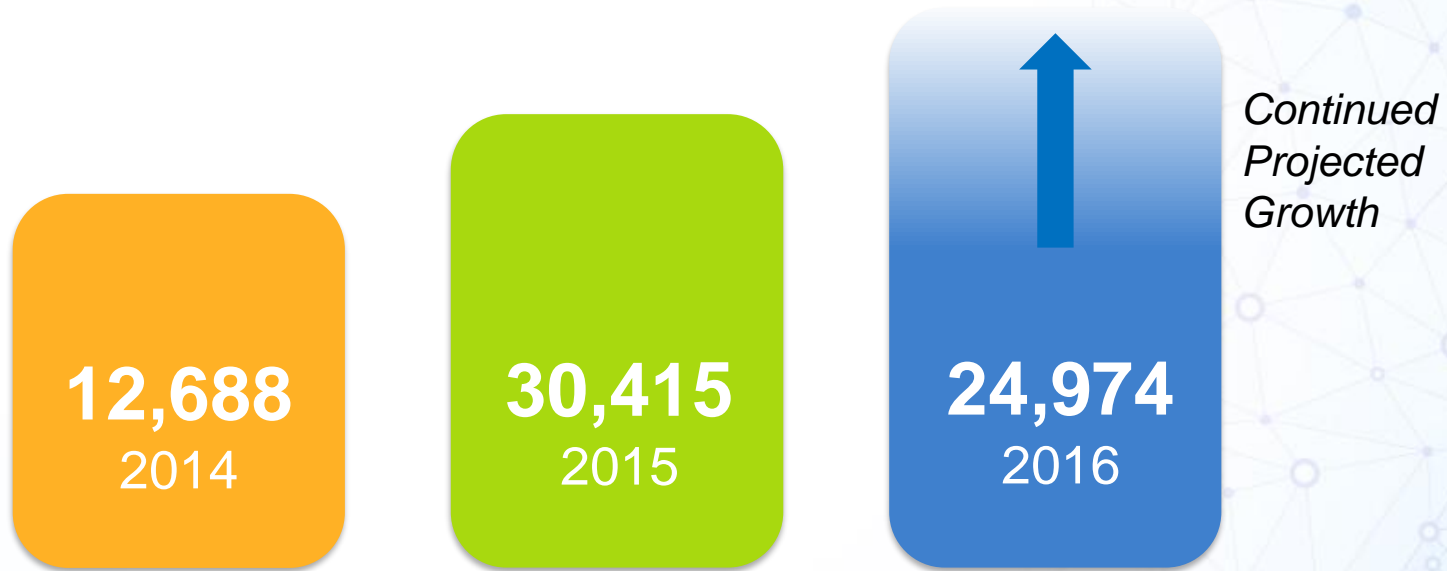

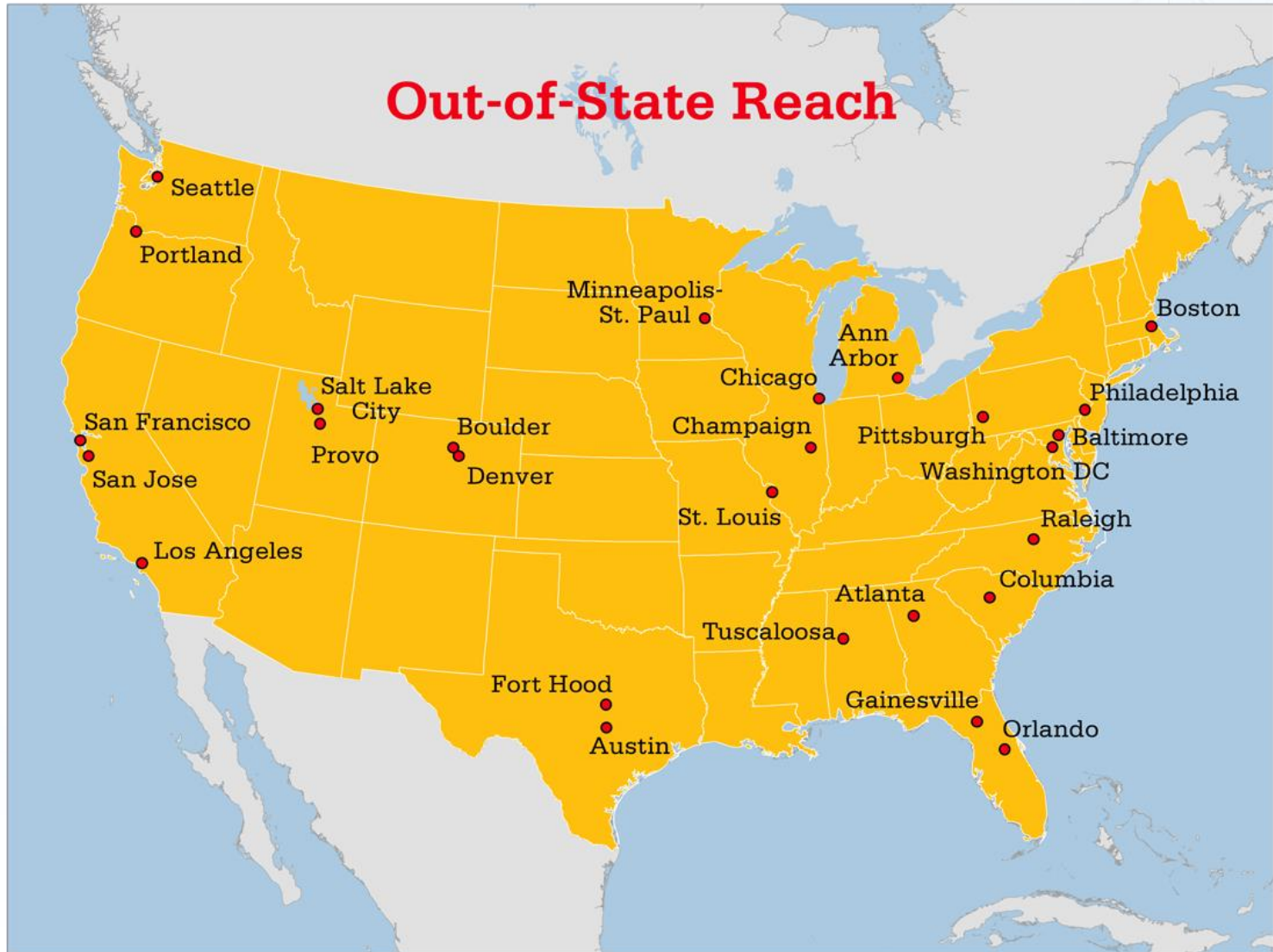

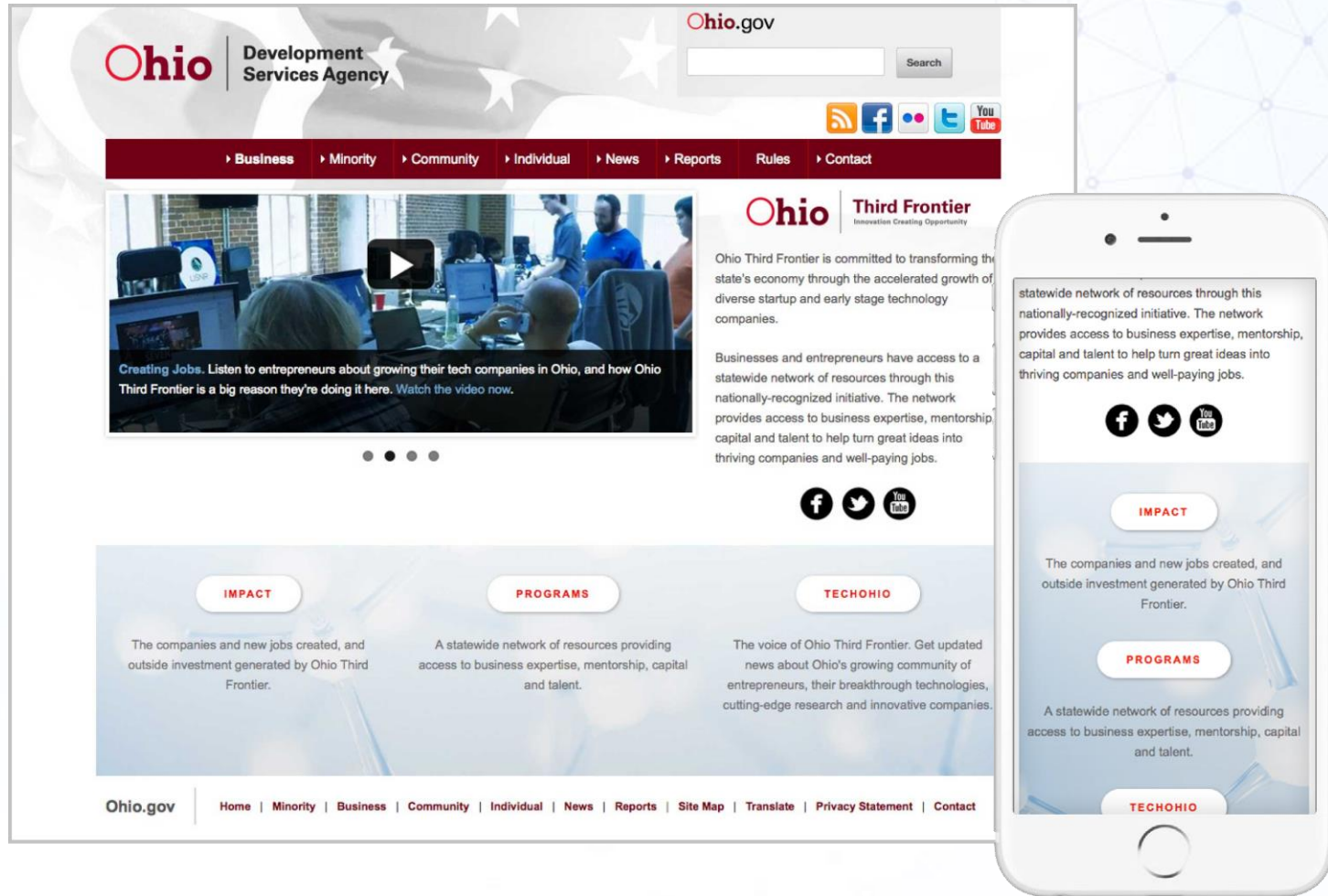

Year In Review: Overview

Requests For Proposals were released for all programs planned for CY 2016 and tracked with the established schedule

In the period from January 1, 2016 to December 30, 2016, expect total awards of \$33 million.

Year In Review: Programs

One round of Technology Validation & Start-up Fund at **\$1.25 million**.
One additional round of Technology Validation & Start-up Fund expected to award a total of **\$3.6 million**

Year In Review: Other

Reviewing 2017–2019 requests for ESP funding, totaling \$27 million per year for the system of six regional networks. Awards will actually accrue to the CY 2017 OTF budget. Deliberations and awards are expected to occur at the October 27, 2016 Commission meeting.

TVSF offered Phase 1 Track B in the current round. Seven Track B fund proposals were submitted. Deliberations and awards are expected to occur at the October 27, 2016 Commission meeting.

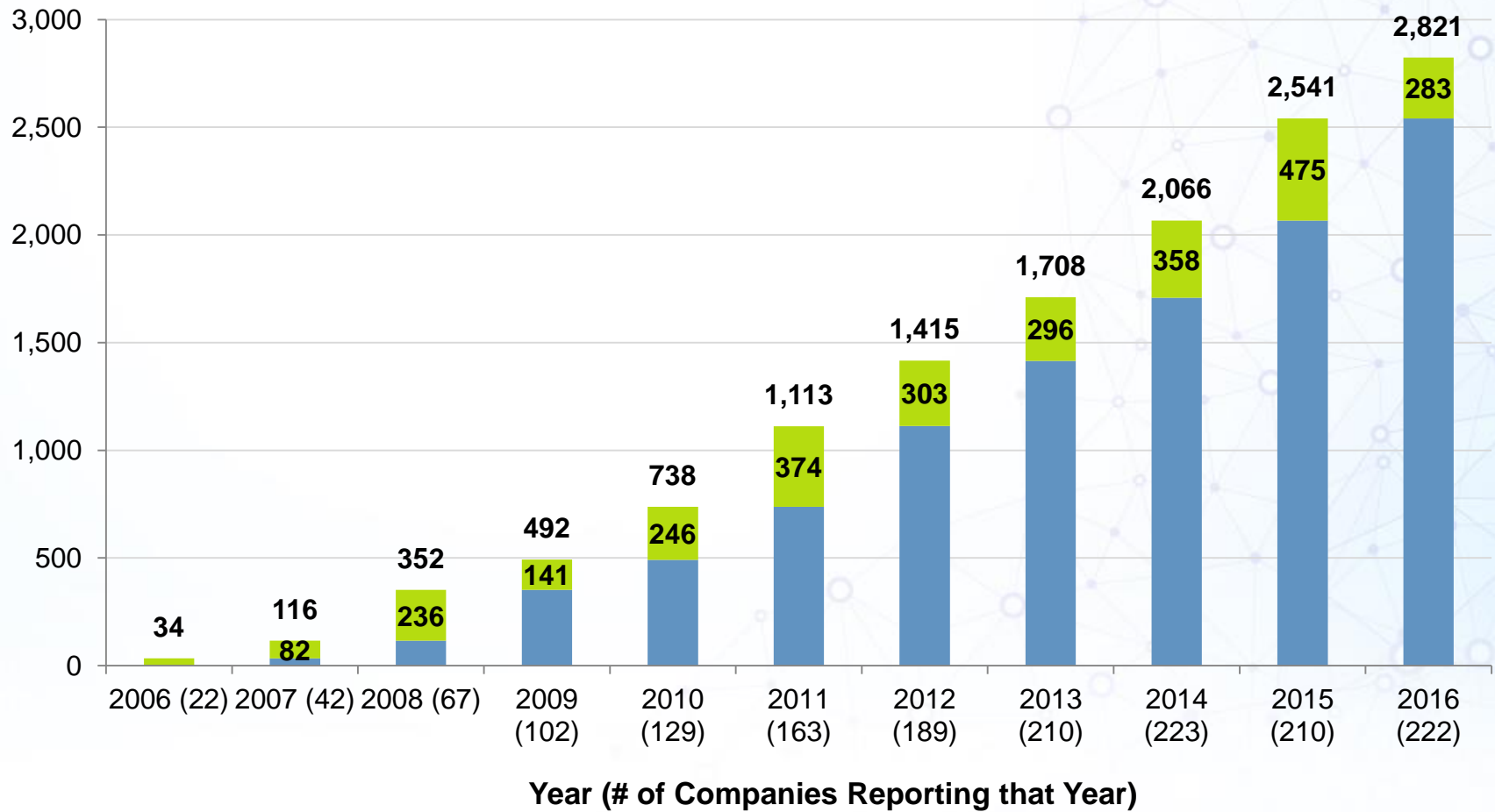

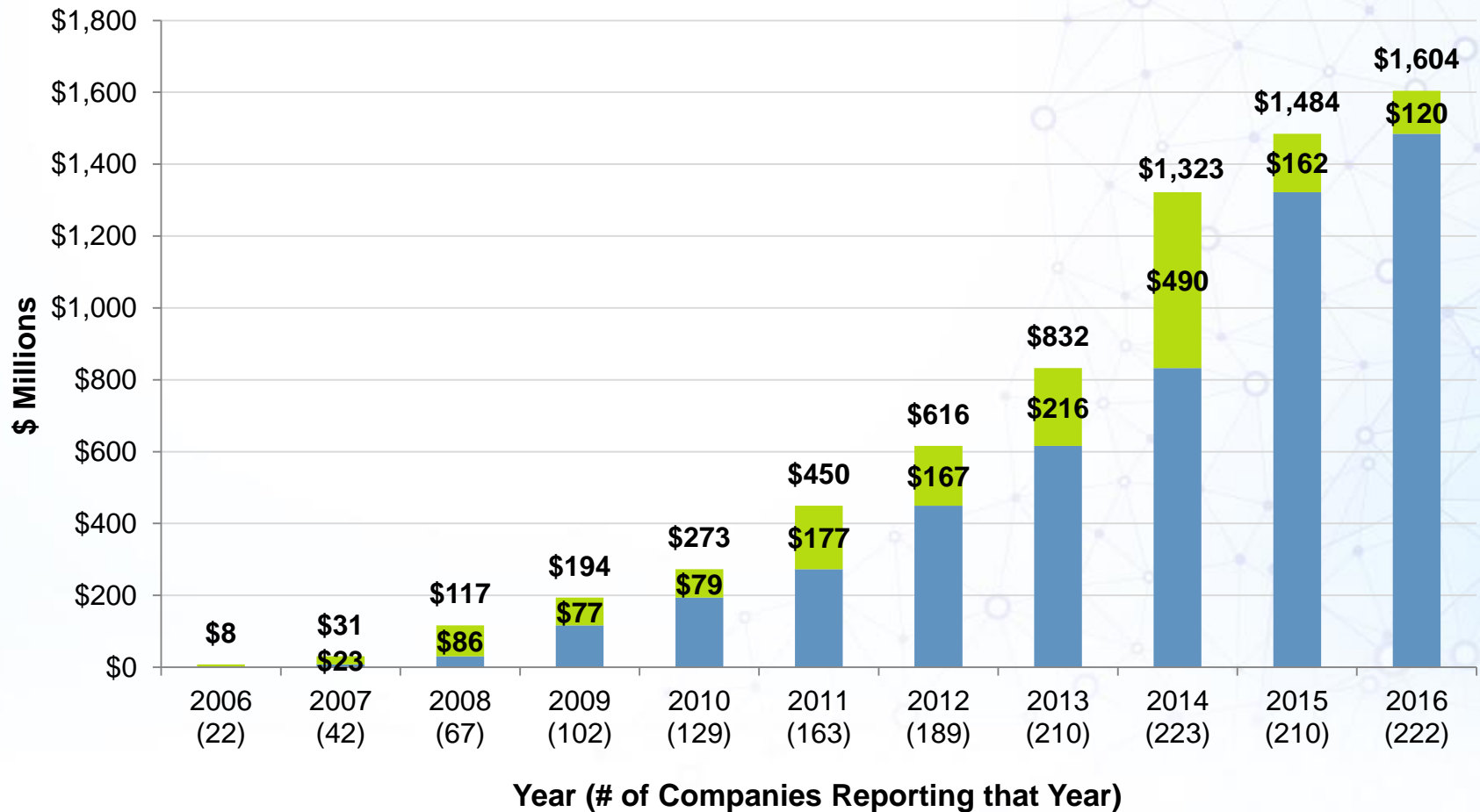
Total New Jobs Created

Green indicates net new job creation from the prior year



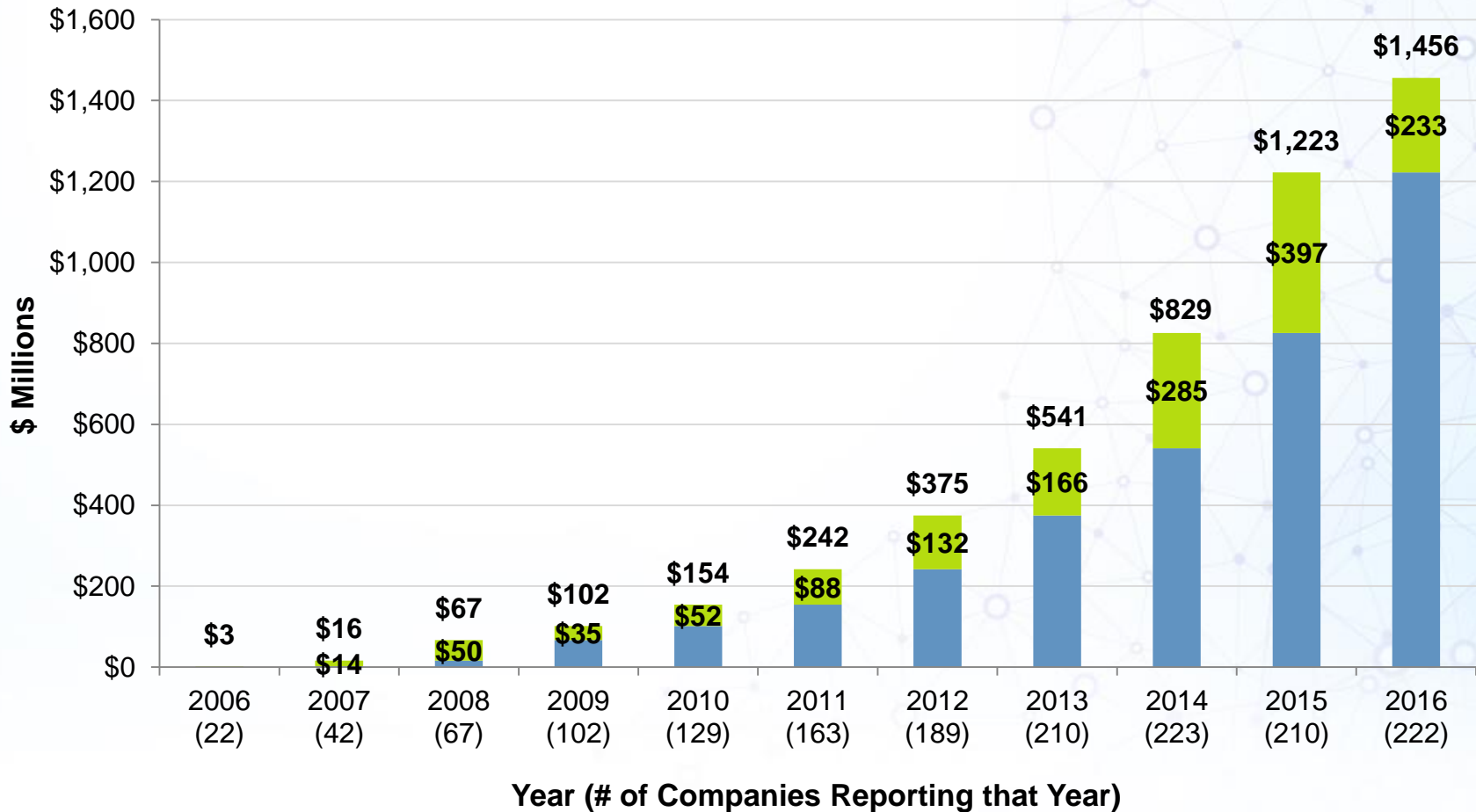
Follow-on Equity Generated

Green indicates new equity generated in that year



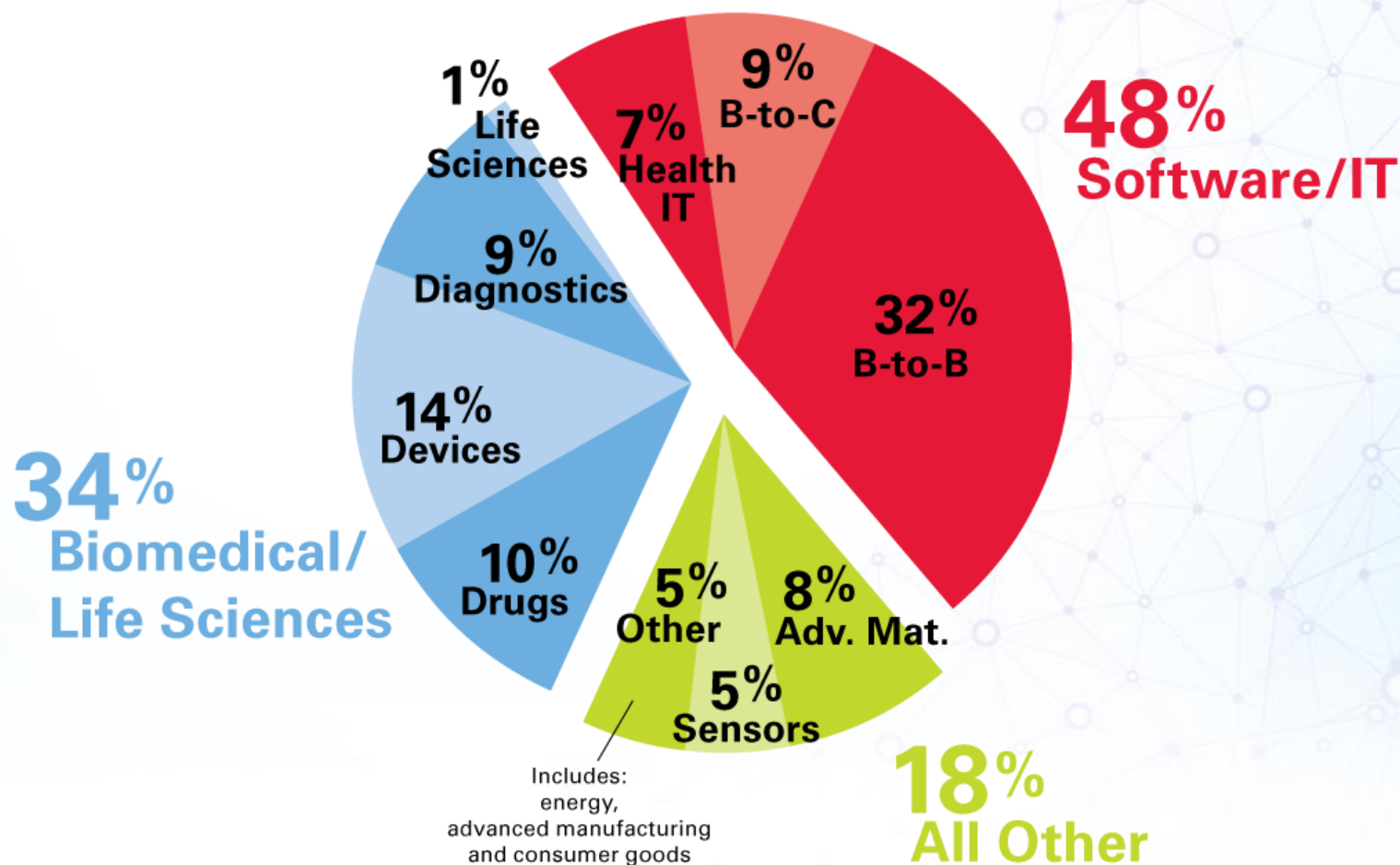
Product Sales / Revenue Generated

Green indicates new product sales / revenue generated in that year



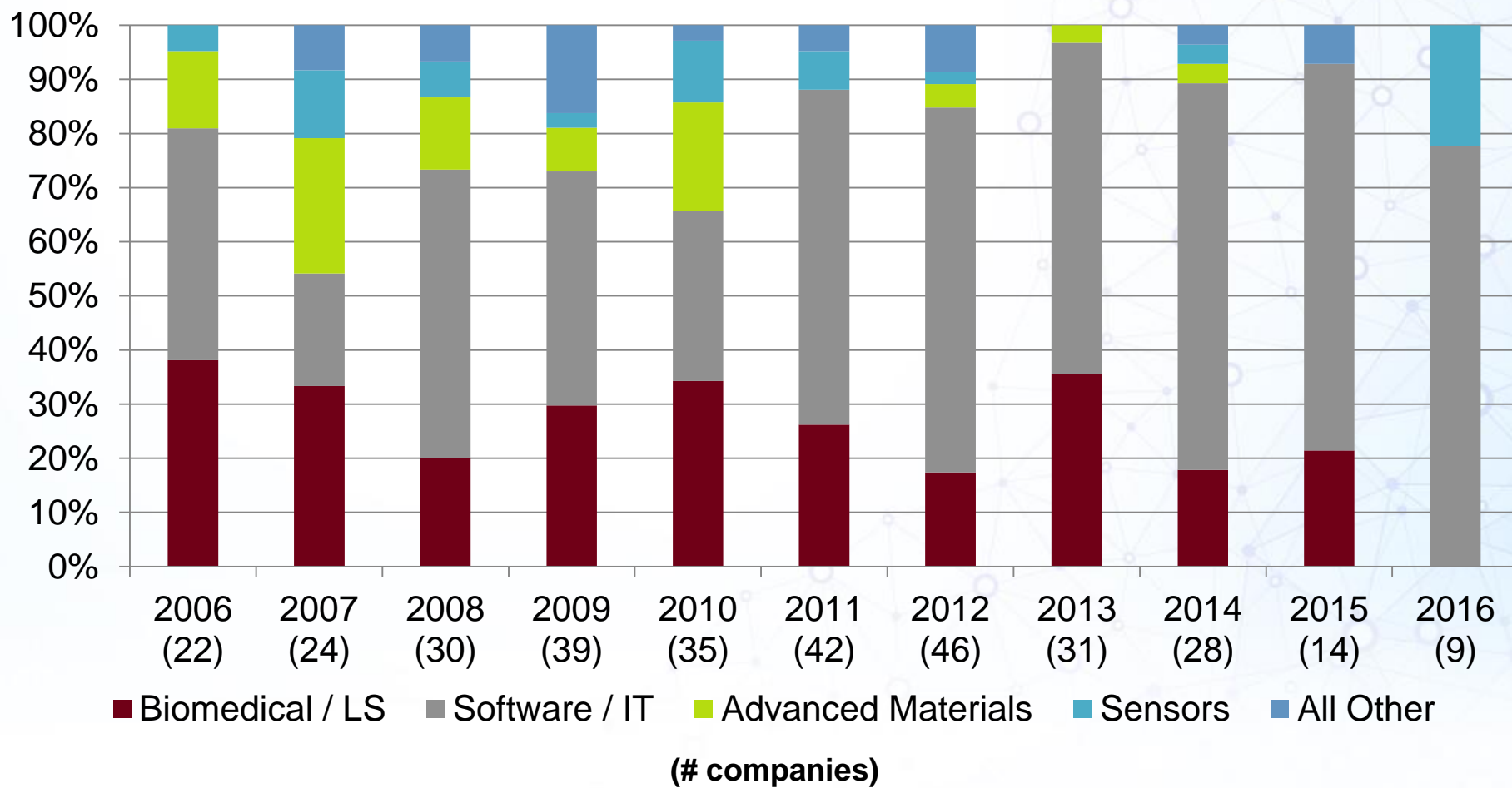
Portfolio Mix by Tech Focus Area

Percentage of total \$ invested for all companies 2006–2015



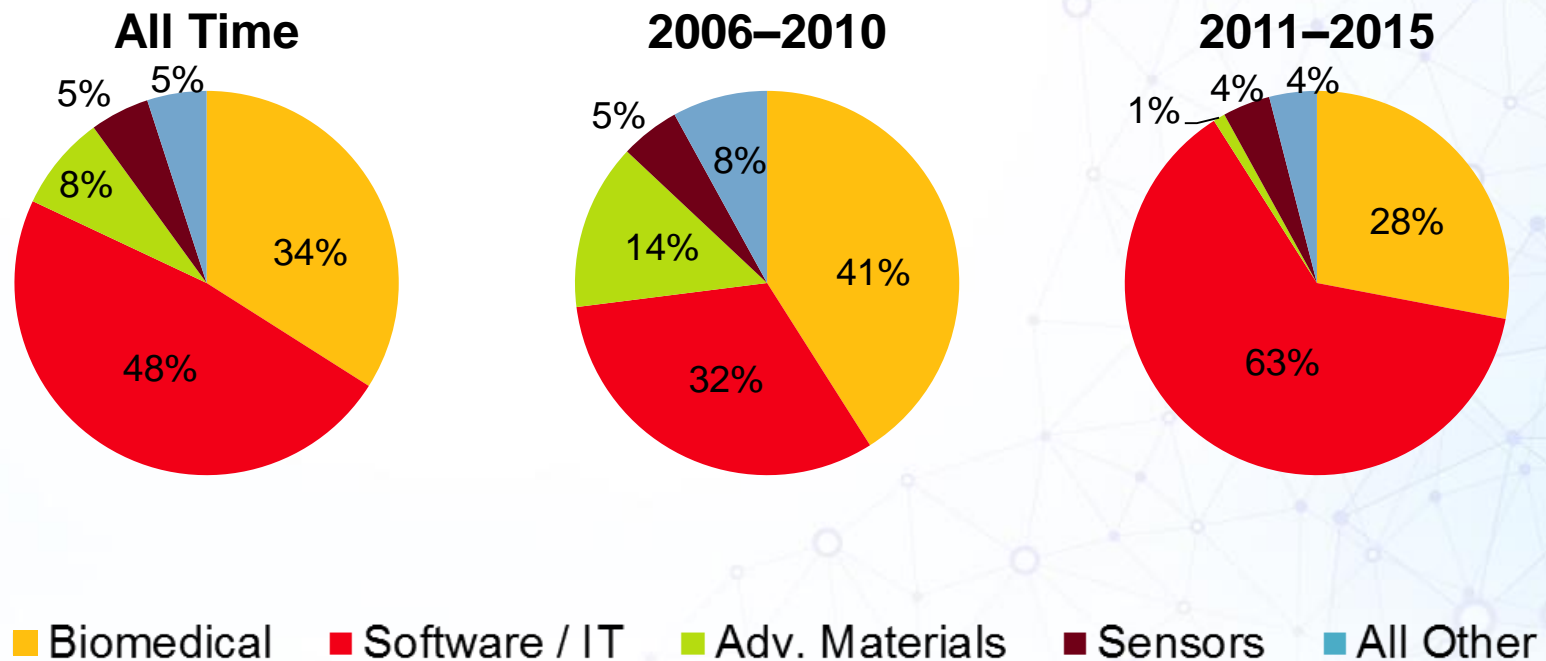
Vintage by Tech Focus Area

Percentage of total \$ invested for all companies by period of investment

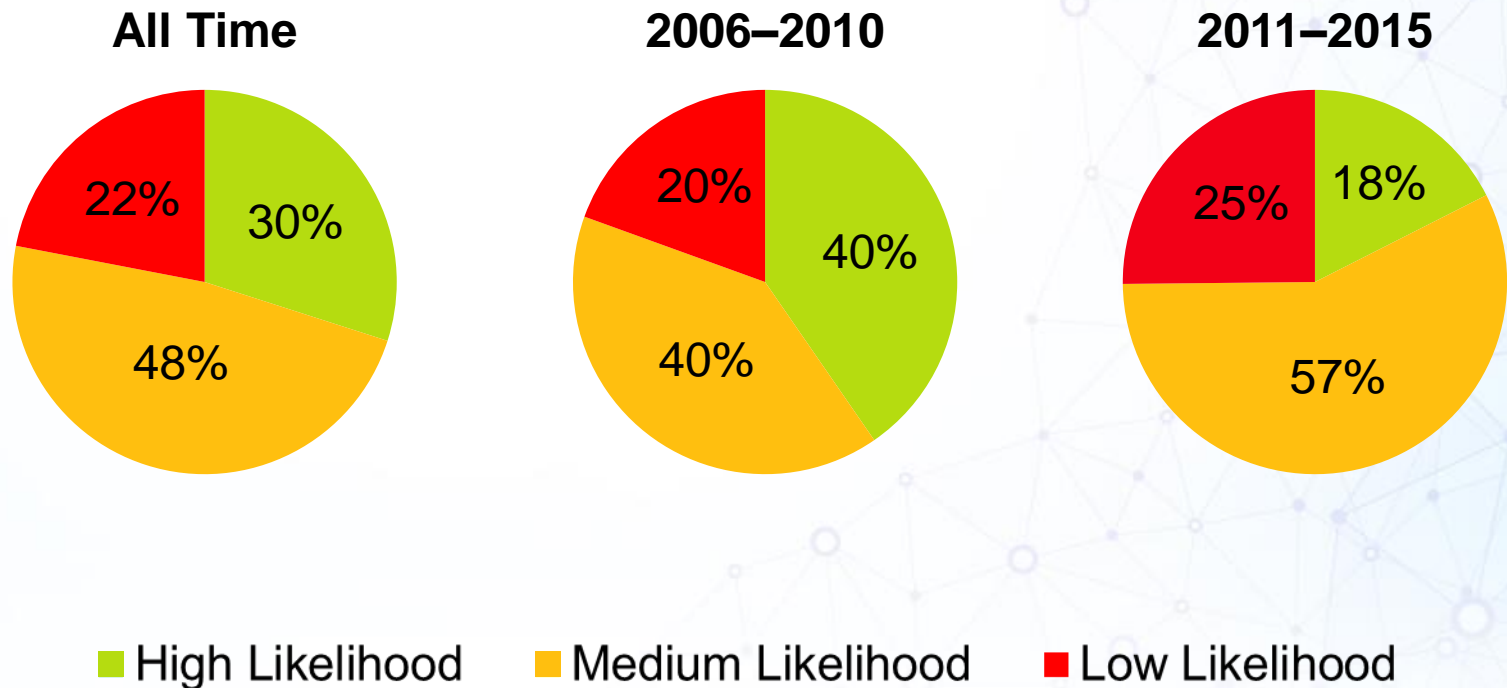

Platform Likelihood over Time

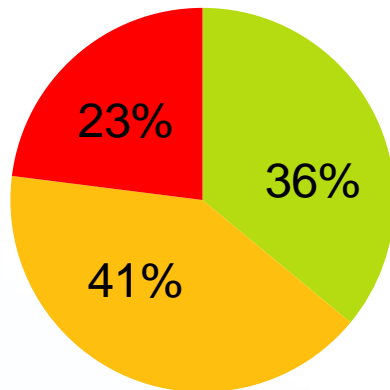
Percentage of total \$ invested for all companies by period of investment



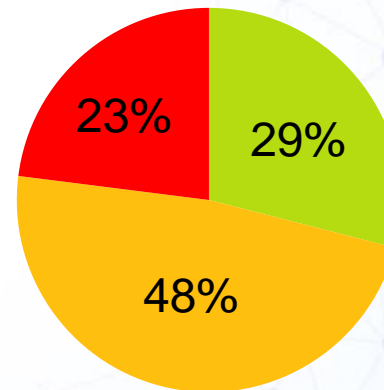
Platform Likelihood by Follow-on Equity (FoE)

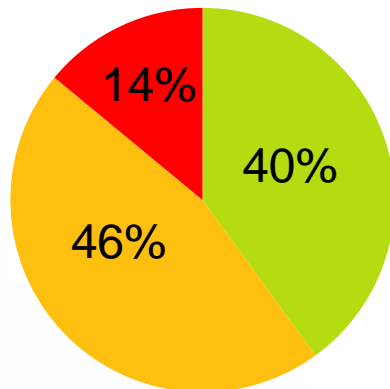

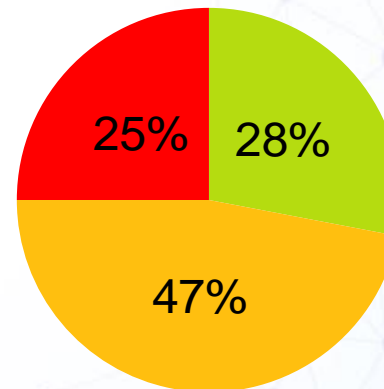
Platform Likelihood by Jobs

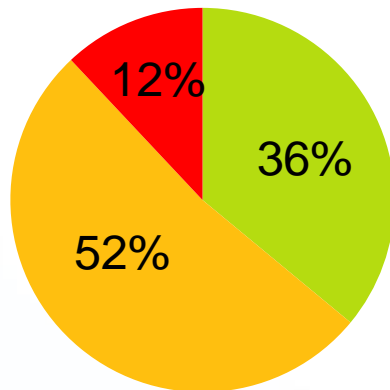

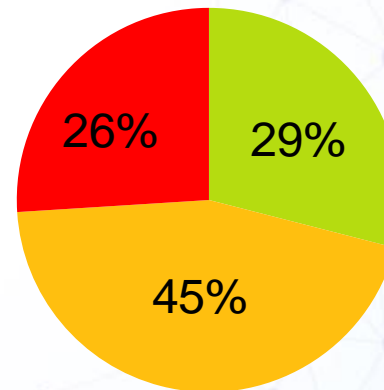
Platform Likelihood by Sales

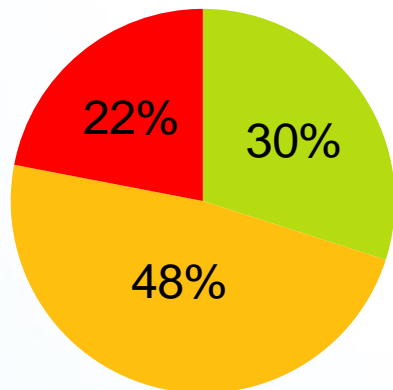

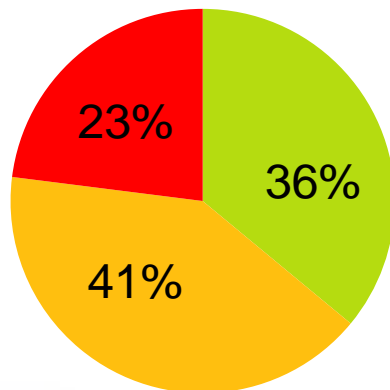
Platform Likelihood by High Performers

Platform likelihood by all companies and metric-specific high performers

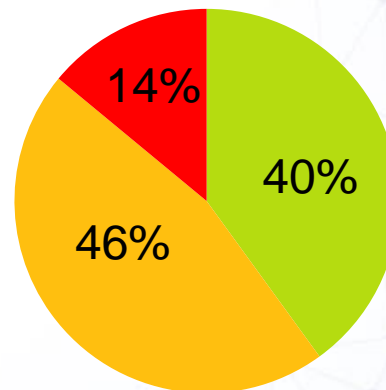

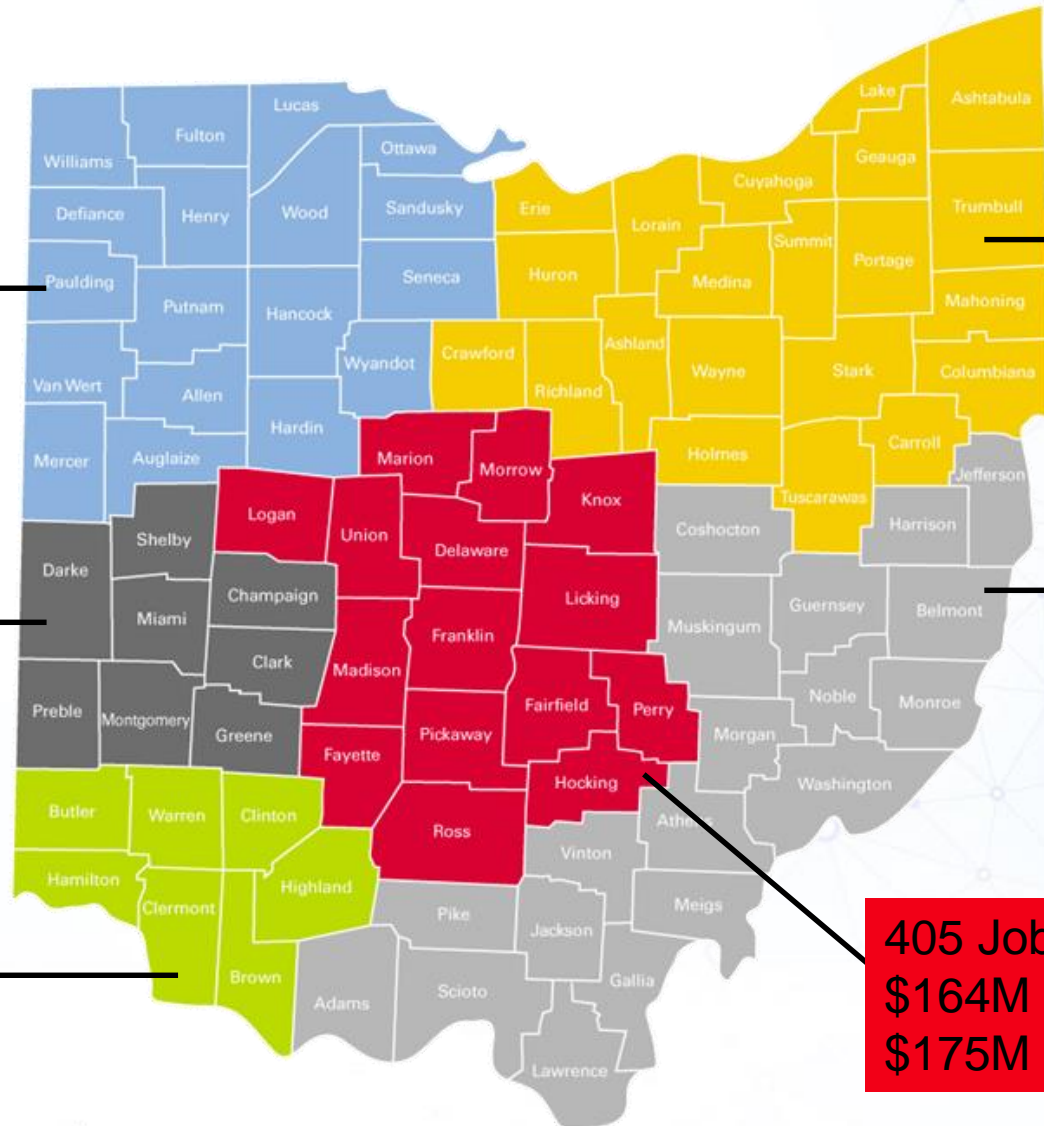

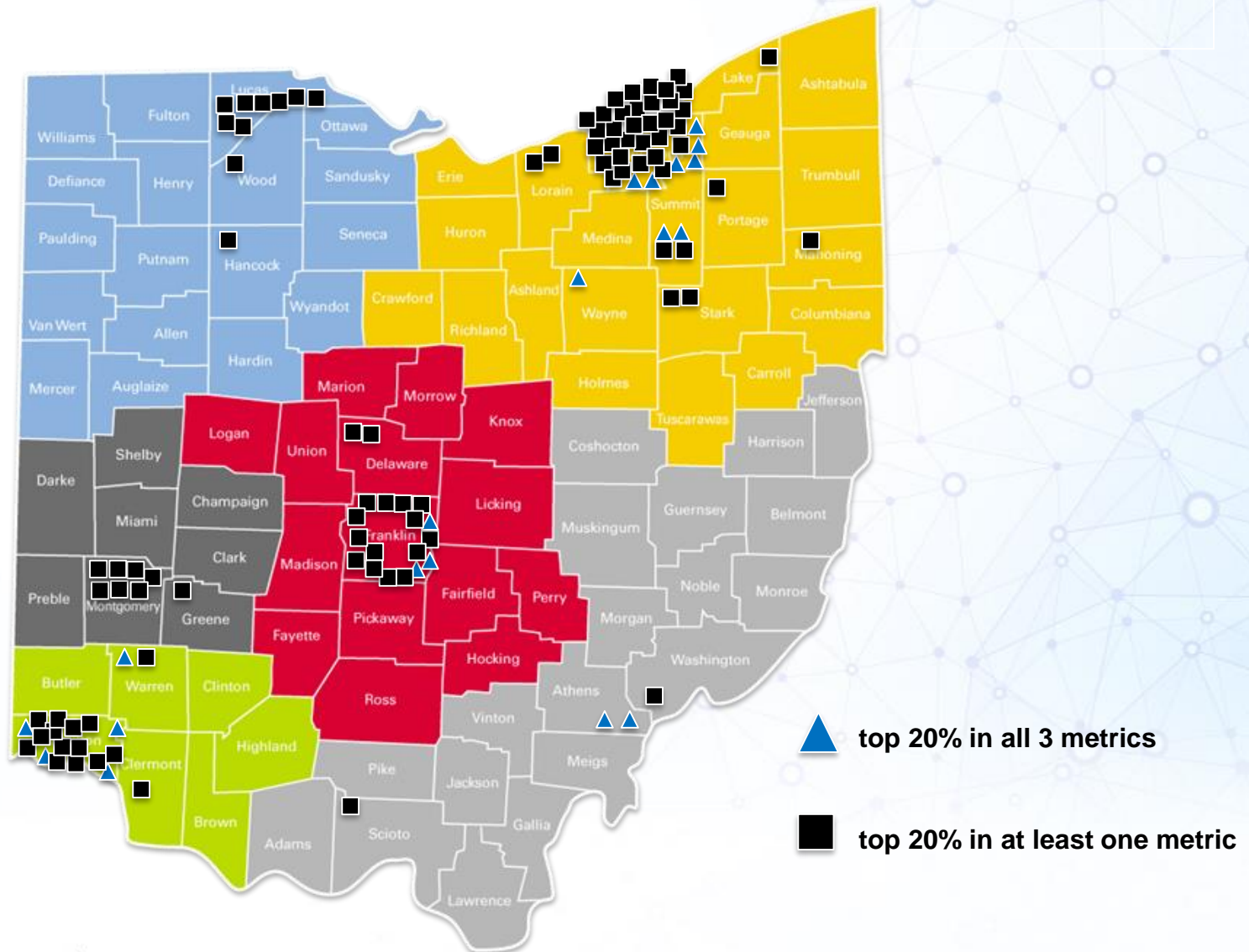

Ohio State neurosurgeon Dr. Ali Rezai says the Neurobridge system pioneered by Battelle and the OSU Wexner Medical Center is one example of the type of projects that could potentially receive help in regulatory and commercial development from Columbus' new Neurotechnology Innovation Translator.

The Ohio State-led center got off the ground with a \$21 million Ohio Third Frontier grant last week and, with numerous public and private investments, it has a \$161 million budget over four years to help spin off and attract neuroscience companies.

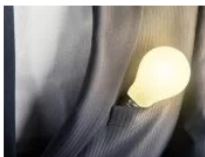

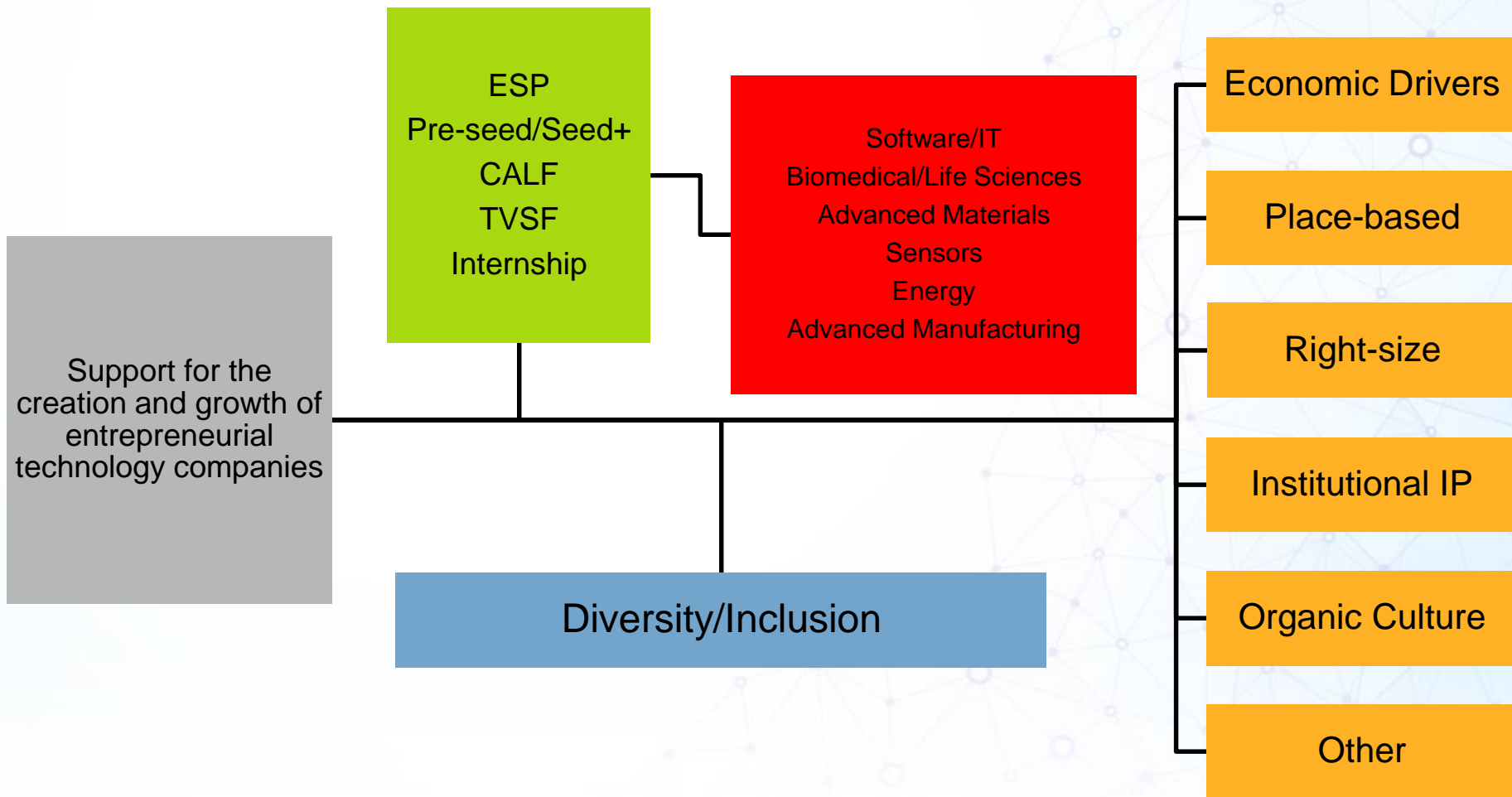

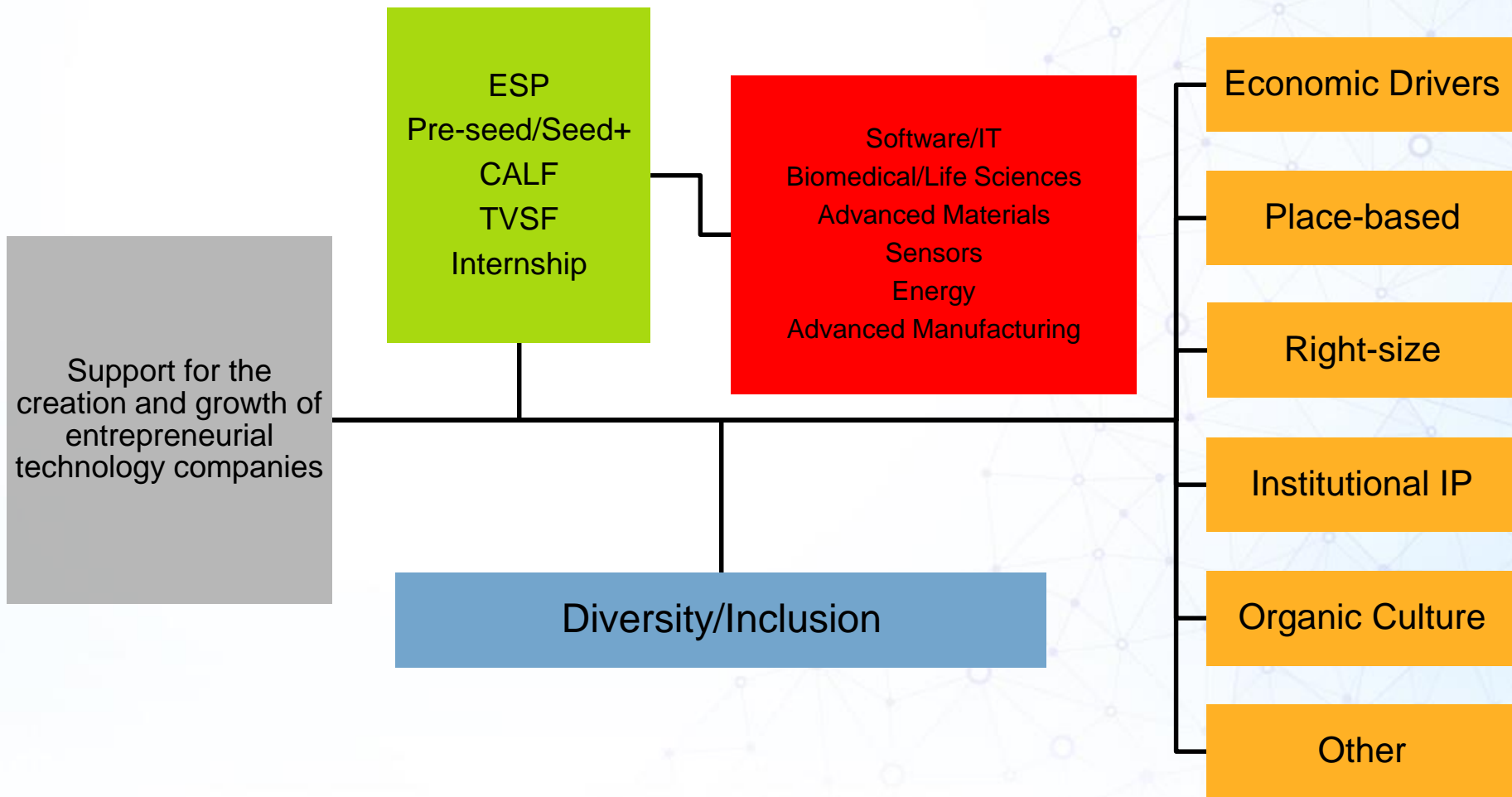
